THE SPIRIT OF PROMISE

By Divine command, Moses transferred the responsibility of leading the Israelites into the Promised Land to Joshua. However, Moses' death discouraged Joshua. So the Lord had to intervene and encourage him for this mission. "Now, therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all these people, to the land I am giving them - the children of Israel." Joshua 1:2

In other words, make up your mind and take possession of the Promised Land. But what does this have to do with the followers of the Lord Jesus today, the New Israel?

The children of Israel were freed from Egyptian slavery and continued to remember God's Promise to "bring them up from that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey." Exodus 3:8 Driven by the strength of this promise, they went out into the desert though they had no tangible guarantee that the promise would come true. The promise that came from the mouth of God convinced them of this reality, although it was unseen.

But now, at the border to the Promised Land, Moses was dead. Their leader was dead, but not the Spirit of the Promise. The Spirit of the Promise does not die, nor does He retract His Word. The Spirit of the Promise testifies with our spirit that His Word will be fulfilled. This is the spirit of the Christian faith.

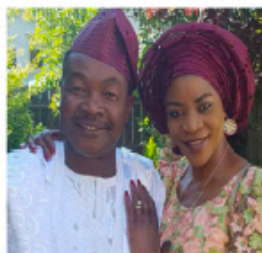
This pearl of revelation cannot be given to swine, nor can the holy Word be given to dogs.



(Matthew 7:6) But those guided by the spirit, who do not see and believe, like Joshua and Caleb, take possession of the promise.

I am happily married and I haven't touched crugs for 20 years. I have my life back! So I don't believe that "once an addict, always an addict", as my own life proves it's possible to overcome.

My advice for anyone who may be struggling with negative habits is: first, decide to fight against the oppression you are going through; second, look for spiritual help and faithfully obey

All five senses are vital and equally important, but things you hear and see can have a lasting effect on you. Maybe life became bitter because of something negative you heard years ago and cannot forget.

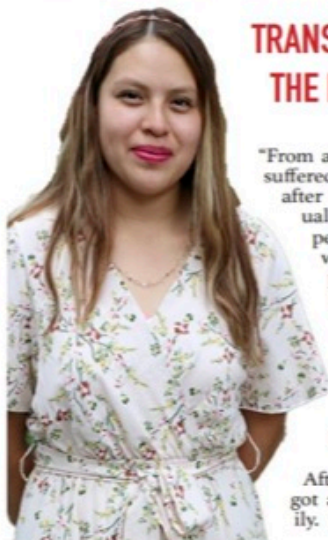
This is the power it has. Go ahead, dive into the Word of God daily and enjoy the benefits!

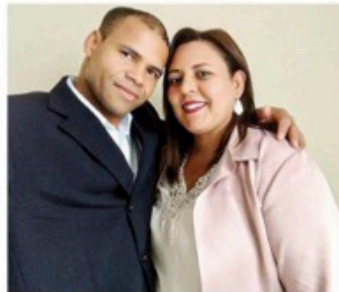
What would happen if a couple decided to do something different for their relationship? These and many other tips and advice await you and your significant other at the Love Therapy.

Just prayer alone is not enough; you need to take necessary actions that will lead to change. As they say, "action speaks louder than words." And it's no different in the world of Faith.

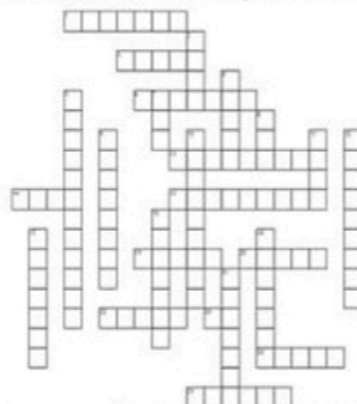

"I COULD'VE LOST MY LIFE... BUT GOD HAD OTHER PLANS FOR ME"

DARREN'S STORY

I went down a path of drugs, having relations with several women, and mixing with the wrong crowds, leading to a messed-up life. I started to sell drugs and affiliate myself with those that were involved in gangs. Things escalated in my life rapidly, and things went from bad to worse.

"THERE WAS A NIGHT WHERE MY HOMEBOY AND I WERE SUPPOSED TO CARRY OUT A ROBBERY, BUT FOR SOME REASON, I DID NOT DECIDE TO GO, AND WORD GOT BACK TO ME THAT HE GOT SHOT IN THE FACE."

However, I never quit. The drug dealing lifestyle led me to go to prison, I spent about two years

in jail, but I had time to think and think about what I wanted and needed to do to change my life. My life was not worth it at all, so when it was my time to leave prison, I already had the mindset: change.

I recognized that I had to let go of some things if I wanted to change; I couldn't hang around the same "friends," so I stopped going to the same spots on the block I would go to before. I spent more time at home than anywhere else. I was focused. I had a family and a girlfriend that I should take care of at the time, who is now my wife and daughter.

At the time, my girlfriend asked me if I needed support through the help of the Universal Church, and I rejected her at

first. But then I decided to join her and started seeking help in the Universal Church. I realized that change was possible. Even now, I recognize God's protection over me; when I did not show up for that robbery that night, I could have lost my life, and God had another plan for me.

Today, my family is blessed, and my wife and I are happy. I went back to school and finished university, found a promising career now, and thank God for the extraordinary transformation He has done in me and in my character; I know what it is to be a man of God and live a clean life now.

If I could change, I know it is possible for you to change, too. I thought there was no hope for me,

but I overcame those thoughts and changed. I was honest, humble to learn, and sincere, and God transformed my life completely.

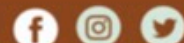


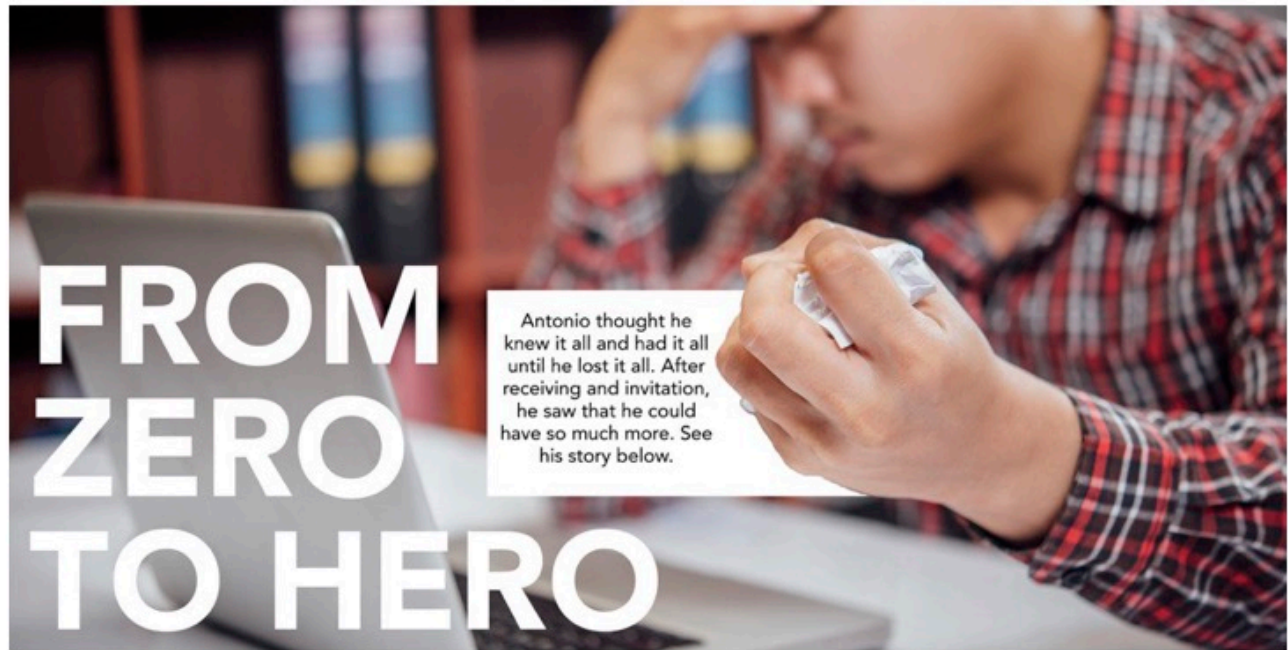
